I go into Newick school on a Wednesday morning at 9am each week to facilitate a Christian Collective Worship for 30 mins and then onto St Peters Chailey to do the same at 10am. I take a story from ‘The Lion Storyteller Bible’ (which I 100% recommend for children) and then ask for helpers to reenact the account/parable. There are always props and dressing up involved!

I wonder if you have any clean, child friendly props at home (wigs / walking sticks etc) that might be useful in these assemblies? Or maybe you would be prepared to make some costumes for me? They have to be child size, non fiddly to put on (we have to get ready in 1 minute with zero dress rehearsal!!!) and suitable for Bible style clothes. I usually use a piece of material with a hole cut in it!
