# FAMILY-FRIENDLY FAITH TALK

**This Sunday we look at Luke 8:26-39 - Jesus Restores a Demon-Possessed Man**

**How to explain Demons to children over 7 years old**

**Main Objective:** The spiritual realm can be tricky to explain to children 7+. However, it is important to communicate to children from Year 3ish (or when you consider appropriate) that there are scary things out there, but that they do not control us. As Christians, we believe in Jesus, who is bigger and better than anything that might scare us. Use words like these -

“What are some things that make you feel scared? In the story in Luke 8, there is something that is scary but through it we see how awesome God is! It has to do with demons. Now, do you remember how angels are God’s helpers? Demons are not like that. They are God’s enemies, and they actually help Satan, who is very bad!!! But you know what? They are absolutely terrified of Jesus.

So, in the story there was a man who had those demons inside of him. He didn’t know Jesus. He was scary to look at as he had not worn clothes or even lived in a house for a long time, because the demons were so in control of him! Jesus approached the man as he knew what was happening, and tried talking to the demons. They recognized Him, too, and they were scared. Jesus asked the demon’s name, and they said “Legion”, which meant there were a lot of them! The demons begged Jesus to let them go into some nearby pigs instead. Now, in Jewish times pigs were considered dirty and untouchable.

Jesus told the demons they could leave the man and enter the pigs...so they did! The pigs went running down a hill into the lake and drowned! When the people saw this, they were upset, and also quite scared. They didn’t know who Jesus was or what he might do to them...not only were their pigs gone, but they saw the man who had been possessed by the demons, and he was quite changed. He was dressed, clean, and sitting up at Jesus’s feet. The people asked Jesus to leave, but the man wanted to stay with Jesus. Jesus told the man that his job was to tell the other people in the village about Him.

So, what do we learn from this? We don’t have to focus on our fears, because God has overcome them and is more powerful than them. Even when things are scary, we can talk to God about them and ask for His help.
