

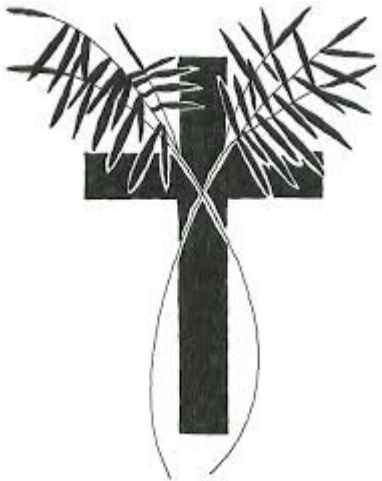
It is only a tiny rosebud.
