We have been granted permission to use Chailey Heritage chapel during building works, which will be from 7th September until 27th November. We will hold a 10am communion service there each Sunday. Parking will be in the North car park off the A272. Stewards will direct you to the chapel. Please leave after the service, not linger or roam the grounds. Social distancing and hand sanitising will still apply.

We hope to hold a harvest communion on the 4th October. Any non-perishable, tinned goods may be brought and will be sent to the Family Welfare team afterwards.

We would like to thank the Tillards and John Millam for the fabulous job they have made of extending the church car park. It is so much better and we do appreciate it.

At the moment we are taking things a week at a time. No rotas will be made until we resume at St Peter's on 29th November. Meanwhile from time to time some people may be asked to read or do prayers on a Sunday depending on who is likely to be there.

We have been working on continuing priest cover but that is becoming very much more difficult as more parishes go in to Interregnum. During August and whilst we are at the Heritage there will be no 8am service. We are hoping thereafter to be able to provide 8am on the first and third Sundays. During winter months covering priests are reluctant to venture out on icy mornings when they have to drive. Thanks to dear Father Martin, our Christmas services are all covered. We hope to have more information on our Interregnum and future by the time we return in November.

APCM: We are hoping to hold the APCM deferred from April, on Sunday 23rd August after the 10am service. Yet to be confirmed but please pencil in your diaries.
