Hello!

It was wonderful to be greeted with such enthusiasm in Church last Sunday (29 Jan) following the presentation about the proposal to create a new Community Café in Chailey Church, initially once a month on a Wednesday 2:30-4:30. The aim of the café is to encourage different generations to feel welcome into the Church to share some refreshments and to also encourage families from CSP Primary school to explore the Church at the end of the school day. Having now established a faithful group of families with babies and toddlers at Possums Toddler group on a Wednesday morning, it is now essential to start to encourage new people to get to know the Church, with the hope that they may wish to get further involved.

The vision is to provide refreshments at the back of the church, with tables set up like a café and for there to be a craft table set up for the children, toys for smaller children to play with in the side section and ideally a prayer station set up at the back of the Church for visitors to view and reflect on a Christian message. Christian songs will be playing as audio. The experience will be about community but immersive in Christianity through sound and visuals.

Thank you to those members of the congregation who stepped forward in faith with offers of help last Sunday after the service. If we have enough volunteers, we will be able to set up a rota and so not everyone will be required every month. I am proposing to run this café once a month on the 1st Wednesday of every month, starting on May 3rd.

These are the roles that need support:

Purchase or Baking of cakes / biscuits (listed ingredients and gluten free option)

Design and distribution of advertising

Production and setting up of a prayer space

Setting up of Church at 2pm

Sorting the audio

Greeting visitors at the door from 2:30

Serving of refreshments

Help with craft table

Chatting to visitors

Clearing up from 4:30

Ideally 8 committed volunteers will step forward for this project.
